You don't have to be gay to join the city's most energetic and massive male choral group (nycgmc.org), which has more than 200 members. You do have to be willing to "not only entertain, but inspire," says member Matthew Levison—the group sings an eclectic mix of songs in



support of causes like marriage equality, LGBT youth and the fight against AIDS. Auditions are held only twice annually, but you can catch the group in March, when it performs its second annual "over-the-top sing-along," as Levison calls it, titled Big Gay Sing 2.
